

# Sources of Wisdom cards

## 1. Describe the topic

Just use the 'Beliefs and concepts' cards.

Can you describe the topic correctly?

Your partner will show you the title side of the card. Say as much as you can about the topic within one minute, scoring 1 point for each statement from the back of the card which you include.

## 2. Identify the topic

Just use the 'Beliefs and concepts' cards.

Can you identify the topic from the clues on the card?

Your partner will read out the clues in reverse order (so that they go from most difficult to the easiest). After each fact, say which topic the clue would match to, scoring 3 points if you identify it correctly from the first clue, 2 points if you need the second clue and 1 point if you need all three clues.

## 3. Match up the topics with the Bible passages

Use all of the cards.

Can you link up the Bible passages with the topic(s) they match with?

Lay out the 'beliefs and concepts' cards with the titles facing upwards. Have all of the 'Bible passages' cards in a pile face down. Taking it in turns with your partner(s), take one Bible passages card at a time and match it to one of the 'beliefs and concepts' cards, scoring one point for a correct match-up and a second point for being able to explain how or why it matches.

## 4. Connect the beliefs and concepts

Just use the 'Beliefs and concepts' cards.

Split the 'Beliefs and concepts' cards equally between you. Put one card down with the title side up. Your partner needs to put down one card which is linked to the first card, scoring one point for matching correctly and a second point for explaining how or why they are linked.
